# Checklist

Keep your operations running smoothly all winter by preparing now.

## 1. Inspect Your Heaters

Task Details	Status
<b>Visual Inspection</b> – Check for visible damage, wear, or rust on heater housing, frames, and wheels.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>Fuel System Check</b> – Inspect fuel tanks, hoses, and filters for leaks or blockages.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>Ducting Condition</b> – Ensure discharge and return air ducts are clean, undamaged, and properly fitted.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>Control Panels &amp; Wiring</b> – Look for frayed wires, loose connections, or corrosion.	<input type="checkbox"/>

## 2. Service & Maintenance

Task Details	Status
<b>Replace Filters</b> – Swap out air, fuel, and oil filters according to manufacturer's recommendations.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>Clean Heat Exchanger</b> – Remove soot, dust, and debris to improve efficiency.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>Lubricate Moving Parts</b> – Apply lubrication to fans, bearings, and other mechanical components.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>Test Safety Systems</b> – Verify all safety shut-offs, flame sensors, and temperature controls are operational.	<input type="checkbox"/>

## 3. Test Run & Performance Check

Task Details	Status
<b>Start-Up Test</b> – Run heaters for at least 15–20 minutes to ensure proper ignition and steady operation.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>Measure Temperature Rise</b> – Compare output temperature to factory specifications.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>Check Fuel Efficiency</b> – Monitor fuel burn rate for signs of inefficiency.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>Verify Airflow</b> – Confirm unobstructed airflow through ducting and fans.	<input type="checkbox"/>

## 4. Prepare for Deployment

Task Details	Status
<b>Stock Spare Parts</b> – Keep extra filters, hoses, belts, and ignition components on hand.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>Secure Fuel Supply</b> – Confirm fuel delivery schedules before the busy season.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>Inspect Transportation Equipment</b> – Check trailers, hitches, and transport straps for safe mobility.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>Label &amp; Document</b> – Mark each heater with identification tags and log its service history.	<input type="checkbox"/>

Task Details	Status
